## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As we celebrate the feast of the Baptism of Jesus, we are invited to reflect upon the significance of our own Baptisms. Do I really believe that I have died to one form of life so that I might live in Christ? What does it mean for me to be a child of God? Do I renew my Baptismal promises every time I sign myself with the Sign of the Cross with holy water whenever I enter or leave St. Alexander church? Do I fulfill my responsibilities to the children of whom I am a godparent?

As the winter months progress, I remind everyone to be careful as they walk on our parish grounds. Many times there are patches of black ice that you cannot see and then you may unfortunately fall. We, at St. Alexander, try to do our best to remove snow and ice from our sidewalks and parking lots but sometimes it is difficult due to weather conditions. Once again, take caution and walk slowly in icy weather.

Please remember that January is the month where we pray for the lives of the unborn. As we live our lives we remember that many children are lost through abortion. Many mothers have lost their lives during abortions and others continue to suffer emotional and physical scars.

Project Rachel reaches out to those mothers who have suffered so much. Project Rachel is a sensitive, private, free and confidential post-abortion reconciliation program sponsored by the Respect Life Office of the Archdiocese of Chicago. When a person has been involved in an abortion which calls for healing, they are referred for counseling to one of the seventy-five specially trained priests or counselors in the Chicago Archdiocese. The meeting with the priest or counselor will generally include counseling, prayer, and scripture. Project Rachel provides post-abortion healing for mothers, fathers, grandparents and siblings of aborted children, as well as abortion providers and those in the abortion industry.

Through this program the Catholic Church reaches out to those broken by the sin of abortion with the power of Jesus' death and resurrection. It is Jesus who heals and forgives through the sacraments, especially the Sacrament of Reconciliation. If you, a family member, or friend needs assistance or would like more information about Project Rachel, please call 312-337-1962. In the meantime, let us all say a prayer for an end to all abortions and a prayer for all who have either died or been hurt through this process.

Parishioners will soon be receiving raffle tickets for this year's Annual Parish Raffle, which supports our school and religious education program. The raffle drawing will take place on March 1<sup>st</sup>.

**SCRIPTURE REFLECTION**



In my second year of theology studies, I went to confession to a priest visiting the seminary for a three-day retreat. My heart wasn’t in it. I was going through the motions. I confessed my sins and waited for his response. The priest said, “For your penance, I’d like you to go into the chapel and repeat the words ‘You are my beloved Son, with you I am well pleased’ (Luke 3:22) until they mean something to you.” Easy penance, I thought.

But to my surprise, I struggled to say those words. I sensed a strong interior resistance blocking them. How could God be well-pleased with me? He couldn’t be, I thought. A battle within me ensued. Two hours later, the resistance vanished, and I found myself able to speak, and claim as my own, those marvelous words. I emerged from the chapel with a new, deep, peaceful conviction that I was indeed God’s beloved son.

Those words are a precious gift from heaven to all of us. Jesus’ baptism, which we celebrate this week, offers them to us. Are we willing to receive these words anew? Many things can block this deepening of our baptismal identity: failings, sins, disappointments, traumas, problems, and so on. Yet God’s love is always greater. This week I challenge you to prayerfully repeat these words over yourself — or perhaps over someone you’re struggling to love — until those words find a home in your heart.



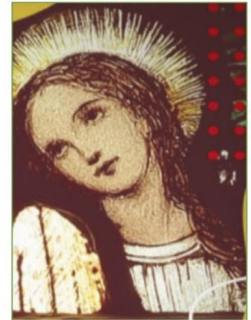
